The Tudor Farmhouse is a historic 20-bedroom hotel in Clearwell, which is undergoing a transformation under the guidance of owners Hari and Colin Fell.

Colin and Hari took over 4 years ago when Hari's parents retired and have set about an ambitious programme of renovations to give the hotel more of an updated feel. The Tudor Farmhouse attracts visitors from far and wide for its tranquillity and also for the excellent food in the restaurant.

Head Chef Blaine Reed returned to his native Forest of Dean to take over the helm of the 2 Rosette Restaurant 2 years ago. Using as much local produce as he can, the hotel has a policy of buying from local producers where available and much of the fruit and vegetables are grown on site.

Blaine's modern British food has recently been described by respected food critic Mark Taylor as "a revelation" with dishes "sure to place him on the radar of the Michelin Inspectors".



The Kitchen offers 2 evening menus to allow diners the choice between a fine dining style of cooking or a lighter and quicker seasonal menu. The new lunch menu has also been carefully written to provide a range of dishes to suit different occasions from a special celebration to a quick business lunch.

This attention to detail extends to the recently refurbished bedrooms where guests can enjoy thoughtful touches such as home-made biscuits. The hotel also offers guests wild food foraging trips with a local expert who also supplies the hotel with wild produce picked in the Forest and Wye Valley.
