Grants and Funding

This has changed considerably in the last months

Central government grant funding for renewables has been reduced, although there is still funding for certain groups and local authority funding is still available for certain types of project. The Feed in Tariffs for electricity producing renewable products such as Solar PV were introduced in April 2010

The proposed Renewable Heat Incentive is now under review and an announcement about the future of this scheme is expected shortly
